Workplace Communications	Certificate completion in Plant Operator or Foundation level trade or other Post Secondary program with a "C" or higher
Workplace Readiness	Completion of a Foundation Trades, Plant Operator program, or other post-secondary program with a "C" or higher, English 12 with a "C" or higher

Business Administration	"C+" or higher in English 12 and Foundations of Math 12 or Pre-calculus 11. Math 12 and at least one Science 11 are recommended
Creative Writing	English 12 with a "C" or higher
Culinary Management	English 12 with a "C+" or higher, Completion of BC Industry Training Authority Professional Cook 2 or equivalent. Prefer Red Seal Journeyman status
Digital Arts & New Media	"C+" or better in English 12 and Apprenticeship and Workplace 11 or Math Foundations 11 or Pre-Calculus 11
Forest Technology	English 12, Foundations of Math 11 and Biology 11 all with a C+ or higher
Human Services Diploma – Child & Youth Care Specialty, Early Childhood Care & Education (ECCE) Specialty, Social Service Worker Specialty Diplomas	English 12 with a "C" or higher, A Human Services certificate such as Classroom & Community Support Worker, Early Childhood Care and Education or Social Service Worker with an overall GPA of "B", or School Chair approval

History	English 12 with a "C" or higher
Math & Statistics	"C+" or higher in Pre-calculus 12 or the equivalent
Nursing	"B" or higher in English 12 and Biology 12 and a "C+" or higher in Foundations of Math 11 or Pre-Calculus 11, Chemistry 11
Psychology	English 12 with a "C" or higher
Rural Pre-Medicine (Associate Degree & Advanced Diploma program)	"C" or higher in Physics 11, and a "C+" or higher in Chemistry 11 and English 12 or English 12 First Peoples or IELTS (minimum 6.5) and Principles of Math 12 or Pre-calculus 12, and two other Grade 12 courses, one of which must be: Biology 12, Chemistry 12, Geography 12, Geology 12, or Physics 12. (Of these courses, Biology 12 and Chemistry 12 are strongly recommended)
