

This is a new course from the University Arts programs. It was questioned if this course was really replacing another course. These are new courses in the Adult Special Education Program. These are for the final component of the program. We need this component so that student feel that they have completed the whole program.

5 "Pursuant to the CIA Section 24(2)(f), Curriculum Committee recommends that CARRIED Education Council approve the changes to ADMN 255 Corporate Finance (3) course outline."

The prerequisite was COMM 241. The new requested prerequisite is ADMN 252.

ADMN 252 covers the first half of the text book, ADMN 255 covers the last half of the same text book. As enrollment increases for the January intake - more students are out of cycle. This currently is forcing the students to take 255 before 252. This is putting the students at a disadvantage, as they are required to complete a harder Finance course without building the initial skill set. This change will allow the students to complete the courses in the proper order and eliminate the skill gaps.

6 "Pursuant to the CIA Section 24(2)(f), Curriculum Committee recommends that Education Council approve the changes to IPHE 402 Physiological Function in the Aged (3) course outline."

#### a. COS form, b. course outline

Streamlined wording to encompass the terminology that is consistent with the Model for Promoting Wellness in Older Adults (Carol Miller). For example, inclusion of terms such as "age related physiological changes", "Negative Functional Consequences" and "Risk Factors"

"Nursing profession" has been replaced with "specific healthcare disciple lens" (as this is an inter-professional course).

Course description, learning outcomes, Teaching & Learning approach, textbook, and Assessment sections were updated.
