

## How to Apply for Admission to Selkirk College courses

All students are required to apply to attend Selkirk College. If a student applies for the wrong program, the application processing is delayed and the student may lose a seat in the course they wish to take.

## New Provincial Instructor Diploma Program (PIDP) applications

You haven't taken any PIDP courses through Selkirk before, but want to start? Choose the following options on EducationPlannerBC – note a \$40 application fee is required:
