A maximum of six "other" courses may be used toward the Liberal Arts and Sciences diploma. A minimum of two must be from first- or second-year UAS courses. - 3) Courses from the Business program at Selkirk College that may be used as "other" credit toward the diploma include TWC 164, MATH 125, ADMN 171, ADMN 180, COMM 220, 240, 241.
